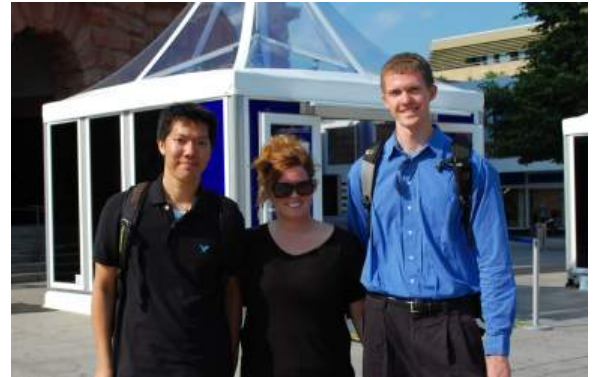


SCHOTT US Summer Internship Requirements & Recruitment Process
